You will learn the basics of Adobe Illustrator and how to create computer graphics. Your work will then be turned into vinyl transfers, which can be put onto walls and windows.

This 2 day course is for G.C.S.E and A' Level students, who want to explore the art of printmaking. You will choose either to develop new personal ideas or work from your course work and sketchbooks – adding that all-important self motivated aspect to your work – sure to impress any examiner!! Techniques include monoprint, collograph and photo etching.

SUPER SIZE ME - workshop 3 wks

It's called sampling in music – when an artist pulls different elements together to make a new and unique piece. In this workshop Artists will learn how to create digital illustrations by mixing photography, drawings and graphics using Adobe Photoshop. Final pieces will then be printed – large scale onto wood.

- Any work created in the workshops will be yours, but we may use it in future publicity, including in print and on the web.

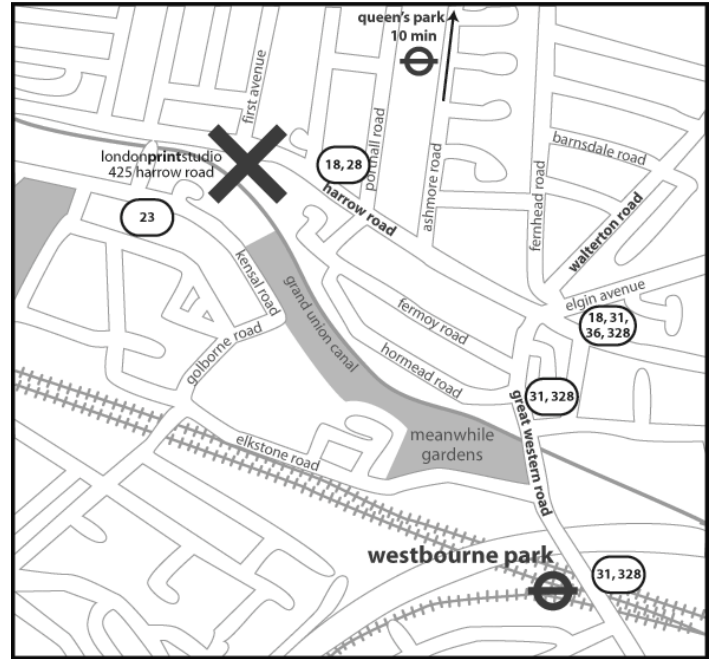

Hammersmith & City Line to Westbourne Park a 10 minute walk

- Go left out of the station, carry on up the hill and over the canal.
- Turn left at the traffic lights
- Walk down Harrow Road, past Somerfield & Iceland supermarkets.
- londonprintstudio is a long glass building on the left hand side of the road opposite a health centre and All Stars boxing gym.



Bakerloo line to Queen's Park station a 15 minute walk

Silver line trains from Euston mainline station (to Watford Junction) via Queen's Park station

- From Queen's Park station turn right out of the station.
- Walk past the bus stop and over to zebra crossings.
- Turn left onto Portnall Road
- Keep walking over Marban Road and Shirland Road until you meet Harrow Road.
- Turn right onto Harrow Road
- londonprintstudio is a long glass building on the left hand side of the road opposite a health centre and All Stars boxing gym.

Central Line to Notting Hill Gate – a bus then a walk

- Take the right exit out of the station
- Walk past Abbey National bank and towards WH Smiths
- At WH Smiths turn right, and walk to the bus stop
- Take a 31, 328, or 28 bus towards Harrow Road, Camden and Golders Green.
- Get off at the Prince of Wales Junctions (where Great Western Road crosses Harrow Road)
- Walk 3 minutes down Harrow Road, past Somerfields and Iceland supermarkets
- londonprintstudio is a long glass building on the left hand side of the road opposite a health centre and All Stars boxing gym.
